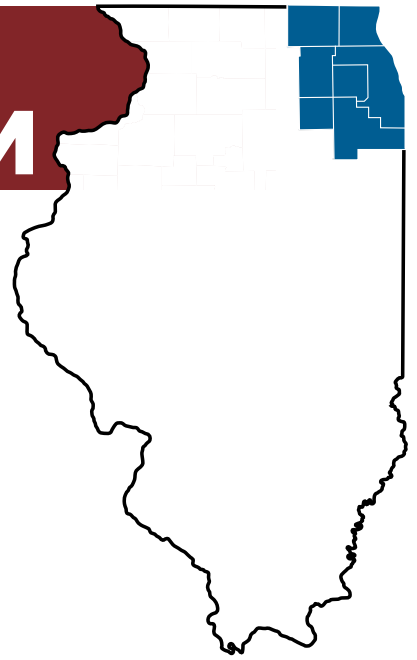

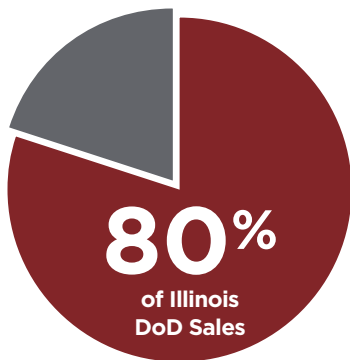

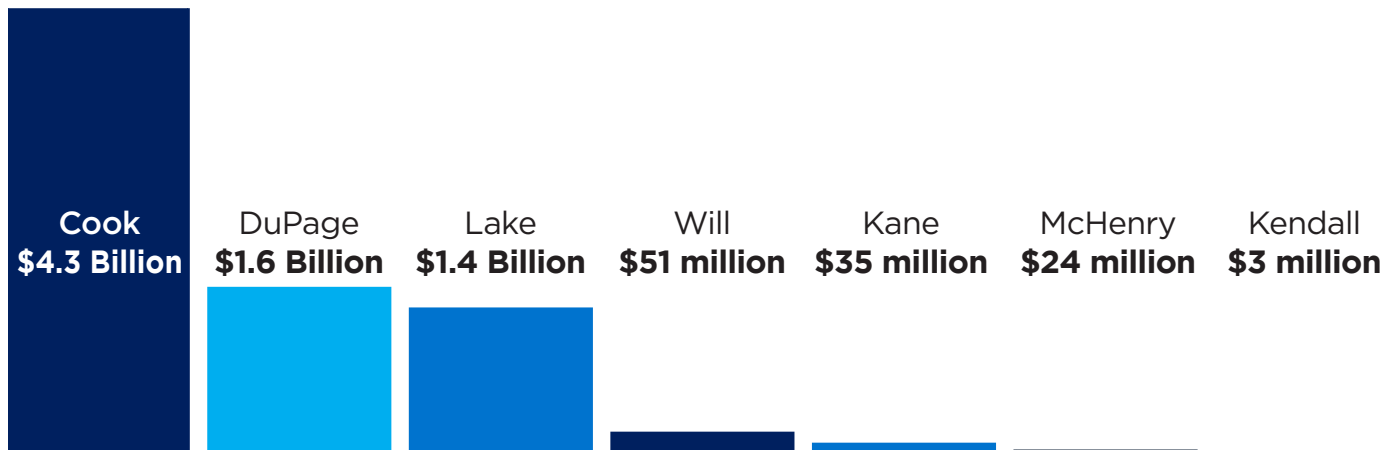

- ▶ Only naval training station in the US

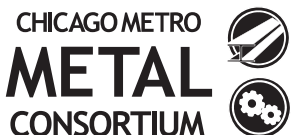
TOTAL COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE SALES IN 2017
